1.3) Procedure followed in decision making process [Section 4(1)(b)(iii)]

i) Process of decision making Identify key decision making points:

For administrative matters, the cases are examined in the Personnel Administration and General Section at the level of Section Officers with the help of Assistants and are put up to the Registrar. Thereafter the cases are put up to the Director General for approval. However, if the Competent Authority is higher i.e. Vice Chairman, Governing Council or Chairman, Governing Council, the cases are put up to these authorities by the Registrar through Director General.

So far as technical matters are concerned the cases are examined at level of JSO/SSO/Manager and are put up to the competent authority through concerned Heads of Divisions.
