- 1. ERNET India, an Autonomous Scientific Society under Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology, Govt. of India, is a Class 'A' Internet Service Provider for the Education and Research community in India. ERNET India pioneered Internet to the country and has been a self-sustaining organization. ERNET has been supporting in proliferating Internet in the country and has been upgrading its infrastructure as per latest state of art technologies. ERNET India as a technology consultant implemented various projects by commissioning ICT infrastructure for teaching aid, Campus Network, Wi-Fi & other IT infrastructure for various ministries, departments, academic & research institutions/universities/colleges/schools under central and state Governments. ERNET India is also providing Internet & other VPN access services to various Institutions, universities, colleges, departments and organizations of central / state government. ERNET India also provides of "C" Band based VSAT based connectivity to the remote unconnected areas. ERNET India is operating Smart Virtual Classrooms across 07 States (Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, Tripura and Gujarat).
- 2. Under its initiatives for identifying newer technologies and testing them on real ground level fields, ERNET India would like to evaluate Free Space Optics (FSO) based technologies for providing connectivity to remote areas where geographical obstacles, such as rivers, hills etc. are hindrance which would otherwise cause delay/prevent fiber optic cable expansion, and lead to significantly increased deployment costs. It is anticipated that FSO based solution will help in achieving the high throughputs of multiple Gbps across long distances.
- 3. ERNET India intends to engage a vendor for deploying the FSOC based connectivity solution at different locations with the focus to improve the connectivity to these remote/ rural parts of the country. The engagement is aimed at deploying the FSOC based connectivity solution in remote areas.

Sealed Tenders are therefore, invited from the eligible manufacturers or their authorized representatives or system integrators in conformity with Technical Specifications as per **Annexure-1A** in conformity with Technical Specifications as per **Annexure-1B** for the detailed scope of work as stated in this document w.r.t supply, installation & commissioning and maintenance of the link(s). The rate(s) quoted by the selected bidder shall be valid for a period of 12 months from the date of signing of agreement and can be used for any repeat order during validity period to deploy & maintain multiple Pilot/R&D FSOC links at various locations in India in different terrains/climatic conditions that impact the technology. Deployment includes supply, installation & commissioning of FSOC links. The bidder shall have to enter into a written agreement on a non-judicial stamp paper of requisite value with ERNET India for complying

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all tender's terms, conditions and warranty maintenance support, in executing the purchase order(s) to be placed by ERNET India.

4. Bidders should note that any query related to any terms and conditions of the tender should be strictly submitted in person to Registrar & CPO, ERNET India with due acknowledgement as per above schedule / details and no other form of communication will be accepted. ERNET will not accept/ entertain any query from any prospective bidders beyond the last date of query submission.
- 6. ERNET India shall organize a Pre-Bid meeting on the queries submitted (by stipulated date & Time) by the Bidders on the scheduled date and time at ERNET India. ERNET India may incorporate any changes in the Tender based on acceptable suggestions received during the interactive Pre-Bid meeting or as deemed necessary in the interest of work. The decision of ERNET India regarding acceptability of any suggestion shall be final.
- 7. Response/clarifications of queries received to ERNET India or any other changes as deemed necessary in the RFP will be uploaded at CPP portal/ERNET India website. No reply in this regard shall be sent to individual bidders. Bidders are advised to keep visiting CPP Portal/ERNET India Website to keep track of updates/ notices during the complete tender process.

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- 8. ERNET India may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by prospective bidders, modify the Tender Document by an amendment. The same will be posted on CPP/ERNET India's website
- 9. Bid submitted by telegram / fax / e-mail etc. shall not be considered. ERNET India shall not be responsible for any postal delay or non-receipt / non delivery of the documents. No further correspondence on the subject will be entertained.

Note 1: In case bidder entity existence in India is less than three years, Bidder's parent entity global presence can be considered with following conditions.

1. Original signed Certificate(s) from practising CA and/or CS should be submitted, declaring that Indian entity existence in India is less than three years and Indian entity is 100% subsidiary of parent entity. This certificate shall be on the letter head of the practising CA/CS and all the relevant documents (summarizing turnover, profitability & net worth) to be enclosed on the basis of which certificate has been issued.

2. Bidder entity should submit the document stating the parent entity constitution, nature of business, country of incorporation, incorporation year and mainline of business.

Note 2: The Bidders are requested to furnish documents to establish their eligibility for each of the above. Relevant portions, in the documents submitted in pursuance of eligibility criteria mentioned above, may be highlighted. If bids are not accompanied by all of the above documents mentioned, the same may be rejected out rightly. Undertaking for subsequent submission of any of the above document will not be entertained under any circumstances. However, ERNET India reserves the right to seek clarifications, as per their discretion.

11.GENERAL CONDITIONS

i) Sealed bids are invited in two part format (Technical bid and Commercial bid) in two separate sealed covers with both the covers to be sealed in a single cover. First cover indicating "COVER FOR TECHNICAL BID" should consist of only Bidder's profile, Compliance sheets with supporting documents, undertaking and all other documents as asked in support of Eligibility Criteria, technical solution, specification, design, configurations of the system/items offered, signed copy of the Integrity Pact (IP) as given at Annexure-5, un-priced bill of material with make, model details, literature, pamphlets, drawing etc. This cover should contain complete technical specifications, make & model, names of supplier/manufacturer and commercial terms etc. of the system/items offered. Price column in this cover should be kept blank. Second cover indicating, "COVER FOR PRICE BID" should consist of item wise price break-up strictly in the format available at Annexure-1C. Price offer should be duly signed and stamped by the authorized signatory of bidder. Both the covers (Technical bid and Commercial bid) should first be sealed separately, and then should be kept in a single sealed bigger cover. This cover addressed by name to the officer signing this enquiry should be submitted before due date and time. All the covers should bear the inscription:

- ii) Bids should be valid for a minimum period of 180 days from the due date or any extended date of bid submission. In exceptional circumstances, ERNET India may request the Bidder for an extension of the period of validity of the bid. The request and the responses thereto shall be made in writing and transmitted through speed post/registered post/courier. The validity of EMD shall also be required to be suitably extended.
- iii) Bids should be submitted on or before the due date. Bids received after the due date & time will be rejected. In the event of due date being a National or public or declared Holiday for Central Government offices, the due date for

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above schedule activities will be the following working day at the appointed time & venue.

- iv) All rates for quoted items/services should be in Indian Rupee for delivery at the premises of ERNET India/end user sites or at any other place in India as and when specified by ERNET India free of charge. Any type of delivery/installation/commissioning or any service or product charges, essential and incidental to acceptance of solution must be inclusive in unit prices quoted by bidder. All prices shall be fixed and shall not be subject to escalation for any reason whatsoever. The rates must be quoted should be in the template provided in Annexure-1C. Commercial bid not quoted in the specified format shall be out rightly rejected. Also, ERNET India reserves the right to correct any of the arithmetical and/or Tax errors in the Vendor price offer.
- v) Bidders should be registered under Goods and Service Tax (GST) and should comply with all provisions of GST. Rates should be quoted giving the basic price, GST etc., if any as per **Annexure-1C**. For other GST terms and conditions, **Annexure-4** to be referred which bidder shall duly signed and submits along with the bid.
- vi) ERNET India reserves the right to accept or reject the bid or cancel the tender proceedings without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- vii) The bidder should quote the products strictly as per the specifications defined in this document or of higher specifications giving exact make & model along with its specifications. All the technical literature for the products offered by the bidder shall be enclosed with the bid.
- viii) ERNET India may waive any minor infirmity or non-conformity or irregularity in a bid or may seek any clarification on the bids, if so desired. The decision in this regard shall be taken by the concerned evaluation Committee & their decision will be final.
- ix) Bidders shall carefully read and sign all pages of the tender document including all enclosures to be submitted with the bid.
- x) The price shall be for delivery at desired destination in India including installation/commissioning and complete operationalization.
- xi) The bidder must quote for all the items in **Annexure -1C** in-line with the items quoted in **Annexure-1A**. In case Zero/NIL value quoted, bidder should provide the justification for same in remarks column of **Annexure-1C**. ERNET India reserves the right to order the line items in any set of combinations depending upon the requirement of client organization/end user. In other words, ERNET India reserves the right to place short / part orders in any fraction based on project requirements.
- xii) Any attempt of negotiation direct or indirect on the part of the bidder with the authority to whom he has submitted the tender or authority who is competent finally to accept it after he has submitted his tender or any endeavour to secure any interest for an actual or prospective bidder or to influence the acceptance of a particular tender by any means, will render the tender liable to be excluded from consideration. The decision of ERNET India in this regard will be final & conclusive and no queries/communication will be entertained in this regard.
- xiii) The bidder will have to arrange for all the testing equipment and tools, cables, connectors, extension boxes and any essentially and incidentally required equipment for installation, testing, maintenance etc. at no extra cost.
- xiv) ERNET India will have the right to reject the components/equipment supplied if it does not comply with the specifications at any point of installation/ inspection.

12.INSPECTION

ERNET India or its representative shall have the right to inspect or to test the items to confirm their conformity to the ordered specifications. The supplier shall provide all reasonable facilities and assistance to the inspection team at no charge to ERNET India. In case any inspected or tested goods fail to conform to the specifications, ERNET India may reject them and supplier shall be bound to replace the rejected goods with the goods in conformity with the specification required free of cost to ERNET India. Any delay due to above shall attract relevant penalty clauses of this document.

13. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT

- (i) Each bid must be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit(EMD) of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lacs only) which shall be in the form of Demand Draft/Pay Order/EM Fixed deposit/Bank Guarantee of any Nationalized/Scheduled commercial Bank taken in the name of ERNET India, New Delhi.
 - a. Bank Guarantee should be valid minimum for a period of 225 days from the submission due date of the bid & to be submitted in compliance with the clause no. (v) of this section. The Performa for submission of BG is enclosed in **Annexure-3**.
 - b. In case of any extension of last date of submission, Bank Guarantee should be extended to minimum for a period of 225 days from the extended due late. This will be applicable only if the extension is given beyond 1 month.
 - c. Response received without Earnest Money Deposit or short of value confirming to the above and /or with short period of validity are liable to be rejected.
- (ii) Earnest Money is liable to be forfeited and bid is liable to be rejected, if the bidder withdraw or amends, impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect within the period of validity of the tender.
- (iii) If the successful bidder fails to submit the performance bank guarantee as per clause 14 within 15 days of the placement of purchase order, the EMD of the successful bidder shall be liable for forfeiture.
- (iv) The earnest money of successful bidder will be returned after submission of Performance Security as per clause 14 below. The earnest money of all the unsuccessful bidders will be returned after signing of contract for empanelment and/or placement of order on the selected vendor. EMD submitted in the form of fixed deposit/BG will be returned as it is. In case of EMD in the form of DD/Pay order, No interest will be payable by ERNET India on the Earnest Money Deposit.
- (v) In view of guidelines issued from ministry of finance, it is mandatory that all the Bank Guarantees submitted must be routed through Structured Financial Messaging System (SFMS) from issuing Bank to our Bank by sending IFN 760 COV Bank Guarantee Advice Message. Thereafter only physical Bank Guarantee will be acted upon. Our bank details for this purpose are: -

(vi) Bidders have to ensure submission of all BGs as per the latest RBI guidelines.

14. PERFORMANCE SECURITY

- i) Bidder shall submit a performance security of 10% of the total value of purchase order within 15 days of the placement of purchase order.
 - a) Performance security may be in the form of Demand Draft / Pay Order / Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) of any nationalized/scheduled commercial bank.
 - b) Performance security should be valid for the minimum period of bidder's service liability plus 3 months from PO(s) issuance. Service liability is defined as the cumulative time period mentioned for delivery, installation & warranty services or any extensions granted by ERNET India.
 - c) In case bidder fails to deliver the items/services (warranty etc.) under the terms and conditions of contract, the performance security so submitted by the bidder is liable to be forfeited.
 - d) Performance security shall be released immediately after the completion of the warranty or any extended warranty period whichever be the case.
 - e) In case of default in terms and conditions of contract during the service liability period, performance security so submitted by the bidder is also liable to be forfeited.
 - f) Vendor is liable to accept the AMC work order within 15 days from issue date. In case of non-acceptance of AMC work order by vendor, performance security so submitted by the vendor is liable to be forfeited. AMC work can be awarded to vendor within the three months from the expiry of warranty period. In such case, AMC rate quoted for the first year will be applicable. After expiry of three month period, vendor has right to accept the order but the rate will be applicable for the balance period of AMC as quoted by bidder.
- ii) In case of any extension in the period of implementation/delivery / installation or any other service liability period, Vendor have to extend the validity of PBG for such period plus 3 months on its own. In case of non-extension (3 months prior to expiry), ERNET India reserves the right to invoke the PBG without any notice to the vendor.
- iii) The EMD submitted along with the Bid response will be returned after submission of performance security as above.
- iv) Non submission of performance security as per above schedule may lead to cancellation of purchase order and/or forfeiture of EMD.
- v) Vendor has to ensure submission of PBG as per the latest RBI guidelines.

15. PAYMENT TERMS

- i) ERNET India shall release the payments on receipt of pre-receipted bill in duplicate as per the following schedule:
 - a) 80% (Eighty percent) payment of the value of purchase order after deducting all penalties (if any) shall be made by ERNET India on completion of delivery, installation, commissioning, acceptance testing, training & acceptance of the ordered link/items along with integration with any existing services.
 - b) Balance 20%(Twenty) percent payment of purchase order after deducting all penalties (if any) would be released in 4 equal instalments during the warranty period (1 year) upon successful completion of every quarter as well as receipt of pre-receipted bill in duplicate. Quarter will start from the date of starting of warranty.

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- ii) The payments will be made as per actual supplied/installed/consumed quantities/items along with due acceptance testing by ERNET India designated officials.
- iii) Payments for yearly AMC (if awarded by ERNET) will be released after deducting all penalties (if any) in 4 equal instalments of receive value of AMC on quarterly basis over the period of AMC support upon successful completion of every quarter.
- iv) The eligible payments to be released to the vendor will further be subject to the receipt of the funds from ERNET India customer institutes/organizations/departments, etc.
- v) In case of any discrepancy between rates mentioned in figures and words, the later shall prevail.

Note: All the above payments will be released subject to the condition bidder has submitted the performance security equivalent to 10% of the total value of the purchase order as per clause no. 14 above.

16.SERVICE LEVEL AGREEMENT (SLA)

- i) After commissioning & acceptance, during warranty & AMC, the vendor shall be responsible for 99% equipment based link uptime. The uptime will be measured from Point A to Point B (Point A and B refer to the end points of the FSOC link) by vendor on monthly basis.
- ii) Failure of any vendor supplied equipment / degradation of equipment performance will be treated as downtime of the system as a whole and attract SLA penalties.
- iii) As the link availability can be impacted due to poor visibility conditions causing throughput to degrade, link availability should be reported regularly in terms of all the parameters namely throughput, jitter, latency and visibility. Non-availability of link availability reports will be treated as equipment downtime. In all such cases, vendor should take corrective actions for enhancing the uptime.
- iv) In case of connectivity failure or any other faults, due to any reasons, vendor should create a ticket id and intimate the end user and ERNET India immediately through mail/fax with appropriate details of ticket id, problem details, site, reason and possible link restoration time. The connectivity failure in a link can be due to hardware or software or backhaul issue or due to poor visibility conditions or due to any other reasons. Hence, the 'reason' field in the ticket should allow to clearly distinguish cause of connectivity failure, such as failure of non-supplied equipment, failure of non-supplied software or failure leading to internet connectivity failure, etc.
- v) The vendor will also liable to provide various types of reports during the operation and maintenance period such as throughput, latency, jitter, uplink-downlink time etc. as described in section 24 and as per the period / frequency defined below:
 - a) Daily reports basis upon completion of acceptance testing until next 2 months.
 - b) Weekly basis after 2 months from acceptance testing until next 2 months
 - c) Fortnightly after 4 months from acceptance testing
 - d) Consolidated report should also be submitted Monthly.
- vi) Vendor shall also submit Analysis & Recommendation Reports on monthly basis. The format of these reports can be created, updated and changed based on the runtime / real time inputs during the execution of the project.
- vii) Vendor should ensure that all supplied equipment installed at sites must be in proper working conditions. If there is any issue related to any of the supplied equipment leading to connectivity issue, vendor has to take all necessary steps to resolve the issue in time bound manner.

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- viii) Vendor should be responsible to perform preventive maintenance with a site visit on monthly basis with a sign-off from the end user/ERNET Project team. The vendor must ensure to submit these signed-off preventative maintenance checks with monthly invoices during the service liability period i.e. warranty/AMC period. Any failure on this will be treated as link being down for such missing period of report.
- ix) Vendor should be solely responsible to coordinate with OEMs of the installed infra and resolution of the system problem to maintain the SLA terms.
- x) Vendor should communicate with service provider, ERNET India and end user agency in cases of any issues pertaining to backhaul internet bandwidth. Vendors should follow-up with concerned service provider for expected time of resolution and same to be informed to ERNET India and end user/agency.
- xi) Vendor should deploy a Resident engineer at site. Resident engineer responsibilities and duties are described in section 21 (xv).

17. PENALTY CLAUSE FOR NON CONFORMANCE TO ABOVE SLA AND DELAY IN DELIVERY

Penalty Clause for SLA:

- i) ERNET India may deduct Rs. 500/- from the due payments or recover from quarterly payments and/or performance security as the case may be for every 1 day of down time at a stretch or in part up to total down time of 03 days. This down time shall be calculated over and above the total hours of downtime permissible. Beyond 03 days of down time, ERNET India may deduct Rs. 100/- for every 01 hour of down time at a stretch or part thereof from the due payments and/or available performance security. Also the absence of resident engineer from the designated site without informing will be treated as a down time for the site and accordingly the above penalties will be imposed. Additionally in the case of absence of resident engineer from the designated site, per day cost of resident engineer will be deducted from the due payments and/or available performance security.
- ii) In any case, if the equipment is not made operational within 15 days from the time of reporting of fault, as against the SLA penalties specified above, the entire amount of performance security submitted by vendor to ERNET India will be forfeited/ invoked and ERNET India may proceed to get the work done at the vendor's risk and cost. Also any due payments from the date of reporting of fault, payable to vendor for the rest of warranty period shall not be paid. This will be deemed to be an event of default/ breach of contract and ERNET India may terminate the contract along with debarring/ blacklisting the vendor concerned for at least three years, for further dealings with ERNET India.

Penalty Clause for Delivery Delay:

The vendor should also be responsible to complete all integration activities in coordination with other agencies in any set of delivered sites within the time defined in the scope of project. Any delay attributable to the vendor in the performance of delivery, installation, commissioning, integration, testing/acceptance and imparting of training, shall render the vendor liable to any or all of the following sanctions:

- a. Imposition of liquidated damage as per clause 19 below,
- b. Cancellation of the purchase order for default,
- c. Forfeiture of its Performance Security Deposit,
- d. Any other action as deemed fit by ERNET such as Debarring/ blacklisting of the vendor.

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Penalty Clause for Delay occurred due to material specifications mismatch:

The vendor should also be responsible to ensure the specifications of the materials supplied should match or are higher than the one stated in **Annexure-1B**. In the event of mismatch found in specifications of goods brought/installed during Inspection or during any other time, the delay occurred to match the specifications should be treated as the downtime and will attract a penalty of Rs.1000/- per day.

18.DELIVERY AND INSTALLATION PERIOD

The awarded site should be delivered, installed, commissioned, tested & made available for acceptance along with integration with backhaul provider within 8 weeks from the date of issuance of the purchase order. Vendor should also arrange the training to the site officials after the acceptance testing within this duration. Site acquisition time and time required for getting the Right of Way (RoW) will be excluded from the time provided above.

19.LIQUIDATED DAMAGES (LD)

- i) If the selected vendor fails to complete the delivery, installation, commissioning, integration and acceptance testing of the ordered equipment/component along with imparting of training by the schedule planned or any approved extended period, ERNET India may at its discretion withhold any payment, as liquidated damages (and not by way of penalty) at the rate of 2% of the PO value per week or a part of a week subject to a maximum of 10% of PO value. The amount towards Liquidated Damage would be recovered from the performance security or the amounts due for the payment to vendor. (PO Value mentioned above would be inclusive of taxes)
- ii) In case the cumulative delay is beyond 5 weeks for each site during the implementation period, ERNET India reserves the right to cancel the purchase order and forfeit all due payments including forfeiture of performance security, besides initiating any action as deemed fit as per rules/laws and/or debarring / blacklisting the Vendor concerned for at least three years, for further dealings with ERNET India. In such a case ERNET India will initiate action to get the work completed at the cost and risk of Vendor and may further distribute such a work to any other agency/vendor.

20.CANCELLATION(S)

- i) ERNET India reserves the right to cancel the tender or modify the requirement without assigning any reason.
- ii) ERNET India also reserves the right to modify/relax any of the terms & conditions of the document by keeping bidders informed about it.
- iii) ERNET India in view of project's requirement may reject the offer, in which any prescribed condition(s) is/are found incomplete in any respect and at any processing stage.

21.SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- i) ERNET India reserves the right to change the requirements under this document at any stage based on the project requirements and directions of end customers.
- ii) In the event of vendor's transfer of ownership/management or the concerned division of vendor, all the obligations and/or execution responsibilities under the agreement with the ERNET India, should be passed on

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for compliance to the new management and should be intimated to ERNET India. Further for the removal of doubt it is clarified that in case of Insolvency/Bankruptcy, provisions of insolvency and Bankruptcy Code 2016 will apply. Vendor need to inform ERNET India whenever such proceeding is being initiated.

- iii) If the name of the product is changed for describing substantially the same or more in a renamed form; then all techno-fiscal benefits agreed with respect to the original product, shall be passed on to ERNET India and the obligations with ERNET India taken by the vendor with respect to the product with the old name shall be passed on along with the product so renamed.
- iv) If any product which is declared end-of-life product before the delivery of equipment, in this case the vendor should supply replaced model with same or next higher model/version of the product from the same OEM and any required additional components without any additional cost. In case, vendor fails to meet any of the service conditions and/or found in breach of any condition(s) of document or supply order, at any stage during the course of its service liability/, ERNET India besides, terminating its order, forfeiting any due payments and/or Performance Security may also debar and blacklist the vendor concerned for at least three years, for further dealings with ERNET India and also may initiate legal action as per rules/laws applicable.
- v) All offered products, software & components should be as per standards, wherever applicable and other standards mentioned in the specifications. An undertaking to this effect should be submitted by the vendor.
- vi) All the equipment & devices should be properly configured. There should not be any vulnerability left in the equipment on any system update/software upgrade. An undertaking to this effect should be submitted by the vendor.
- vii) If bidder refuses to accept the purchase order within 15 days or any extended period from the date of issue of purchase order from ERNET India, the offer would be treated as withdrawn and bidder's EMD will be forfeited, ERNET India reserves the right to debar and blacklist the bidder for at least three years, for further dealings with ERNET India.
- viii) A detailed Bill of Material as in **Annexure-1A** has been prepared as per the defined scope of work & enclosed herewith. However, it is the bidder's responsibility to see the completeness of the solution and if required bidder may quote for additional items/equipment as prescribed in the format annexed at **Annexure-1A** to complete the proposed solution design and work.
- ix) The hardware specifications provided in the document are the minimum required and bidder may quote for higher specifications to optimize as per their solution requirements.
- x) Bidder shall submit the relevant documents as necessitated in this document. Relevant portions, in the documents submitted may be properly marked. If offer is not accompanied by all of the documents asked, the same would be rejected out rightly. Undertaking for subsequent submission of any of the above document will not be entertained under any circumstances. However, ERNET India reserves the right to seek clarifications/ additional documents, as per its discretion.
- xi) During any stage of verification / evaluation / assessment, if in case any information (including any document furnished by the bidder is found to be invalid/forged/ false, their offer shall be summarily rejected, their EMD shall be forfeited and no correspondence on the same shall be entertained.
- xii) Vendor shall remain fully responsible and liable for complete scope of work despite partial / whole sublet of scope of work to any other agency by bidder for completion of project work.
- xiii) ERNET India may transfer the link operation and maintenance to state/end user after the installation and acceptance. In this case, all the vendor liability of the tender will be transferred to state/end user.

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- xiv) AMC cost will be proportionately calculated based on the items selected by ERNET India for complete solution.
- xv) Vendor will have to provide Resident Engineer at installation site during the service liability period.

Responsibility and duties of Resident Engineer (RE) posted at site: -

- To ensure that all FSO equipment at site must be in proper working conditions. If there is any issue related to the FSO equipment, RE need to ensure their timely resolution
- To manage complete installed system on daily basis to ensure smooth running of equipment.
- To coordinate with OEMs / Service provider for logging and resolution of the installed system
- To coordinate with user/state agencies for handling issues pertaining to connectivity
- To provide operational training to user/state agencies in case of any specific requirement
- Conduct the test as desired by ERNET India/end user and submit the reports as described in section 24.
- To take all necessary steps essential and incidental to ensure proper functioning of solution

22.EVALUATION of Tender

- i. The evaluation process of the tender proposed to be adopted by the ERNET India is indicative only and to provide the Bidders an idea of the evaluation process that the ERNET India may adopt. However, the ERNET India reserves the right to modify the evaluation process at any time during the Tender process, without assigning any reason, whatsoever, and without any requirement of intimating the Bidders of any such change.
- ii. When deemed necessary, during the evaluation process, the ERNET India may seek clarifications on documents submitted in their respective bids or ask the Bidders to make Technical presentations/demonstrations/PoC on any aspect from any or all the Bidders. However, that would not entitle the Bidder to change or cause any change in the substance of the tender submitted or price quoted.
- iii. A duly constituted Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC) will first select eligible Bidders on the basis of eligibility criteria of this tender. The Bids conforming to the eligibility criterion will be considered for further evaluation.
- iv. A duly constituted Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC) will shortlist Technical Bids on the basis of technical solution, design, conformity of technical specifications, suitability of offered solution, parameters and features offered vis-à-vis tendered specifications requirements. If required, the short listed Bidders may be asked for a detailed technical presentation/discussion on the solution and products offered in the bid. One of the criteria for selection would be to prefer the vendor who can provide zero or minimum number of repeater for sites. Bidder shall submit the block/architecture diagram of the solution proposed, considering the below example of the site located in Nagaland.

Further, TEC may ask the bidder to bring any selected items/sub items of their quoted products for technical evaluation at ERNET India or any other location decided by TEC in specified time limit. In case,



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bidder fails to bring their quoted products within the stipulated time, for whatever reasons, their bid will not be considered for further evaluation.

- v. The names of technically short listed bidders will be announced to only those bidders whose bids will qualify for opening the Price/Commercial Bids.
- vi. The Price Bids of only those Bidders short listed from the Technical Bids by TEC will be opened in the presence of their representatives, if any present, on a specified date and time to be intimated to the respective Bidders by ERNET India, and the same will be evaluated by a duly constituted Commercial Evaluation Committee CEC) and determine successful bidder.

Note: In their own interest the bidders are advised to ensure that the equipment quoted by them should conform to all tendered technical parameters/specifications and are functional. Equipment quoted and not meeting complete tender specifications or lower in specification will not be considered for evaluation.

23.SCOPE OF WORK

- i) The vendor will be fully responsible for survey, supply, installation, commissioning & maintenance of Free Space Optics (FSO) based connectivity links at location(s) anywhere across India. The location(s) will be specified by ERNET India.
- ii) The Free Space Optical connectivity will also have to be integrated with an existing Internet connectivity and enable the site(s) to access WAN/LAN, internet, its related applications and services using internet.

iii) Offline Survey

a. ERNET India shall share a list of tentative site(s). Each site will have to be offline surveyed and a detailed survey report will have to be submitted within 7 days of intimation of site(s). As FSO is LoS (Line Of Sight) based, the vendor will conduct an offline survey of all project sites asked by ERNET India and submit sites feasibility report for all sites.

iv) Physical Survey

- a. The vendor shall perform physical survey of shortlisted site(s) within 15 days of the issuance of non-commercial letter of intent (LoI). In case of remote sites / locations with difficult terrain, duration of physical survey may be decided on mutual discussion. **Site survey reports** shall contain following information:
 - 1. Vendor shall details of site(s) with photographic markings along with exact coordinates for placing of the equipment & distance between sites with clear Line of Sight (LoS) check.

2. Vendor need to provide map of site survey.

3. Vendor to provide a plan with Position for the placement of Rack (containing switches/router /UPS etc.)

4. Length of Fiber required for connecting the pole to Rack.

5. Vendor need to provide the Pole(s)/tower(s) height & angle of elevation for getting clear line of sight between the sites.

6. Vendor shall ascertain minimum distance between two identified sites.

- 7. Vendor shall provide details of backhaul connectivity provider, the bandwidth (in mbps) intended to be provided by backhaul infrastructure, interfaces planned for backhaul connectivity and remote end, backhaul equipment details, any specific backhaul interfaces to be requested etc.
- 8. Vendor shall provide details for any site where any Right of way is required. Also details of any defence establishment in between the sites.

9. Network topology/diagram, Finalization of pit Location for Pole(s), recording the Pole Length required for clear line of sight.

10. Vendor shall check for lightning protection at the sites

11. Availability of Power supply for devices in Rack and for communication unites.

12. Vendor shall provide any dependencies on State and/or ERNET India

- 13. Vendor shall provide details of any futuristic obstruction over period of time like a probable building if being constructed/ any trees in line of sight (a few feet extra space to be kept)
- 14. Vendor shall check the need of repeater. If the repeater is required, repeater site need to be surveyed based on above mentioned applicable points.

15. BoM and specification

- 16. The vendor may provide any other relevant inputs/pre-requisite required for the deploying the solution
- Based on the physical site survey report(s) and other factors such as permission required for sites etc. Vendor should submit the project implementation plan (PIP) for each site within 10 days of accomplishment of the site visit.

PIP shall consist of at least following inputs

Site Completion Schedule with planned dates for milestones such as

1. Civil Work Completion, Backhaul Availability

2. Installation start and end date, Commissioning Complete

3. Vendor Testing Complete

4. ERNET India acceptance Testing Start

5. Review & Rework of documentation and reports -Training, Maintenance Start

6. Periodicity and Date of Availability of Reports

b. Vendor may add more relevant inputs / information to PIP.

c. The PIP shall be submitted as a Gantt chart in spreadsheet.

ERNET India may issue the PO to vendor once the physical site survey is completed along with submission of above mention reports and PIP.

Civil and Electrical Works & Transportation V)

a. The vendor will be responsible for all the necessary civil works such as pit making, masonry works and pole installation. The pit making and pole installation request along with relevant details must be submitted to State for necessary approval from local authorities / states and must share a copy of same for purpose of information. The same must be attached as a part of Installation and Commissioning Report.

b. The vendor will be responsible for provisioning of electrical wiring from the mains to the point of UPS

installation (nearly 100 meter on an average) in each site.

- c. The vendor will be responsible for all necessary electrical related jobs to be conducted at the site relevant for FSO installation including essential earthing, lightning arrestor / other electrical safety equipment pertaining to installations etc.
- d. The vendor will be responsible for all the relevant material transportations required for FSO E2E integration & maintenance

vi) Installation

In order to install the FSO equipment on pole/tower:

Vendor will make necessary survey related to alignment of FSO equipment, height of the pole(s)/towers(s) to place the FSO, the required depth of pole/tower inside the civil structure/ground to ensure the steadiness of pole/tower.

- b. Vendor will ensure the safe, steady & durable mounting and installation of FSO on the pole(s)/towers(s).
- c. The vendor will be responsible for placing the equipment (L2 switches, UPS, Batteries etc.) in a metallic safe rack with lock and key. It must be noted that all the equipment must be labelled and labels shall include IP address for applicable components.
 - i. The provisioning of rack safety, steadiness and hence its appropriate placement shall be ensured indoor and outdoor conditions.
 - ii. The rack shall have an End to End Setup Diagram picture with clear IP addresses in use

vii) Integration

- a. The vendor will perform the integration of its FSO equipment with Switches; switches connected to with the backhaul interfaces & L3 wireless routers as required.
- b. All offered equipment; software & components should support seamless inter-operability among them.
- viii) To ensure "zero downtime" due to lack of electrical power supply, electrical power to the complete system must be connected via UPS with battery backup for uninterrupted continuous connectivity.

ix) Acceptance Testing

- a. No item with short supply or alternate product with different technical specifications shall be taken up for conduct of acceptance testing under any circumstances.
- b. The vendor is responsible for creating the User Acceptance Test (UAT) Plan. The vendor shall share the document for review well in advance (within 3 weeks of PO issue date) and shall re-work and add the inputs provided by ERNET India into final User Acceptance Test Plan. The final UAT plan shall be formally signed off after the review by ERNET India before the actual UAT is done by vendor. The UAT plan may be updated based on feedback/learnings from the implemented site(s).
- c. The vendor is responsible for showcasing the maximum pass results during user acceptance testing (UAT) to ERNET India and/or other designated officer by ERNET India.
- d. The methodology of UAT may be by physically visiting the site or any other manner as decided by ERNET team.
- e. The vendor shall create a UAT result report and if required share the appropriate logs for each of the test cases as a result of UAT.
- f. Vendor should obtain an acceptance testing certificate from the ERNET or designated official from ERNET, which will be submitted to ERNET India along with the bills.
- g. During the UAT, ERNET India reserves the right to reject any item, if found unsuitable and /or not conforming to the approved specifications. The rejected items, if any, shall have to be taken back and replaced by good items forthwith at the cost of the vendor. No payment will be made for rejected items and replacement
- h. Failure to fulfil any of the aforementioned conditions will entail cancellation of the Purchase Order along with forfeiture of the Performance Security. Further, ERNET India may procure same items from alternate sources at the risk and cost of the defaulting vendor.

x) Training and Handover

- a. This will include the submission of System Operation User Manual, Configuration & Maintenance Guide containing at least the following:
 - i. E2E setup diagram with configured IPs, components details and information, default settings/configurations, how to configure, restore the components & system.
 - ii. Information and snapshots of successful restoration of various components.
 - iii. Information about the LED indicators on all components in the system including FSO equipment & guidelines to find out successful restoration of each of them.
 - iv. FAQs about the failures scenarios & its recovery mechanisms do's and don'ts during emergency conditions, contact details of responsible engineers for support and maintenance.

- v. Steps for system software upgrades/downgrades for various components.
- b. Vendor shall coordinate and organize hands on demo session as a part of training and handover on per site basis.
- c. The training shall include the basic operations of installed equipment, supporting testing tools if any, day-to-day handling of equipment and basic level troubleshooting to the maximum of two member of each project location for one day. All the training materials will be provided by the vendor.
- d. As a part of handover, Vendor shall share the list of materials and physically cross verify the same with the nominated state representative.
- e. Vendor shall provide user manual in English & Hindi to end-users detailing operations of the equipment and on-site user level training at the time of installation after getting approval from ERNET. Also the Vendor has to perform the work of equipment tagging at all project sites.
- f. On completion of training (scope as defined above) Vendor shall submit the detailed diagram/drawings & documentation of the project, training manual to the end user/ERNET India and obtain a certificate from the End user which will be submitted to ERNET India along with the bills.
- xi) Analysis & Recommendation Reports To be submitted as per details mentioned in SLA section & List of deliverables
- xii) Support and Maintenance
 - a. The Vendor shall arrange for maintenance for a period of warranty from the dates of acceptance of the project with regard to rectification/removal of defects if any observed during this period. The comprehensive onsite warranty of 1 year shall begin from the date of acceptance of the site.
 - b. Warranty shall include free maintenance of whole equipment supplied with complete system including free replacement of faulty equipment/parts, free software upgrades/ updates/ renewals/ replacement of batteries. Any issue reported from site shall be attended to on immediate basis.
 - c. The Vendor is required to quote for Comprehensive AMC of two years on per year basis after warranty period is over. AMC should be quoted separately in commercial bid. AMC cost for two years will also be taken into account for commercial evaluation. However, award of AMC order will be at the discretion of ERNET India or its user(s). The offer received without quotes for Comprehensive AMC would be out rightly rejected. Vendor have to submit relevant proofs of back-to-back support purchased from respective OEM under warranty/AMC supports if so asked by ERNET, failing which the payment for such warranty/AMC period as per clause 15 (i) / (iii) will not be released.
 - d. AMC cost provided in percentage (in **Annexure -1C**) shall be quoted on basic cost of items excluding GST.
- xiii) Template of all the reports (as part of deliverables: clause 24) can be customized as per needs / requirements and dependencies arising during the operations.

25.INDEMNITY

The successful bidder shall indemnify the ERNET India/End-user departments against all third party claims of infringement of patent, trademark/copyright or industrial design rights arising from the use of the supplied items and related services or any part thereof. ERNET India/End-user department stand indemnified from any claims that the Bidder's manpower may opt to have towards the discharge of their duties in the fulfilment of the purchase orders. ERNET India/End-user department also stand indemnified from any compensation arising out of accidental loss of life or injury sustained by the Bidder's manpower while discharging their duty towards fulfilment of the rate contract and purchase orders. The Bidder shall solely responsible for any damage, loss or injury which may occur to any property or to any person by or arising out the execution of the works or temporary works or in carrying out of the contract otherwise than due to the matters referred to in this agreement hereinbefore. The Bidder would ensure for observance of all labour and other laws applicable in the matter and shall indemnify and keep indemnified the ERNET India/its customers against the effect of non-observance of any such laws.

26. FORCE MAJEURE

If at any time, during the period of contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligation under the project is prevented or delayed by reasons of any war, hostility, acts of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts or acts of GOD (hereinafter referred to as "events") provided notice of happenings of any such event is duly endorsed by the appropriate authorities/chamber of commerce in the country of the party giving notice, is given by party seeking concession to the other as soon as practicable, but within 21 days from the date of occurrence and termination thereof and satisfies the party adequately of the measures taken by it, neither party shall, by reason of such event, be entitled to terminate the contract, nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance, and deliveries under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable situations after such event has come to an end or ceased to exist and the decision of the purchaser as to whether the deliveries have so resumed or not, shall be final and conclusive, provided further, that if the performance in whole or in part or any obligation under the contract is prevented or delayed by reason of any such event for a period exceeding 60 days, the purchaser may at his option, terminate the contract.

27. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

- i) Default is said to have occurred
 - a) If the bidder fails to accept the purchase order(s)
 - b) If the bidder fails to deliver, install and commission any or all of the equipment/ services within the time period(s) specified in the purchase order or any extension thereof granted by ERNET India.
 - c) If the vendor fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the contract
- ii) If the Bidder, in either of the above circumstances, does not take remedial steps within a period of 10 days after receipt of the default notice from ERNET India (or takes longer period in-spite of what ERNET India may authorize in

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writing), ERNET India may terminate the purchase order in whole or in part. In addition to above, ERNET India may at its discretion also take the following actions: a) forfeiture of its Performance Security and/or any due payment, b) imposition of liquidated damage as per clause 19 above or/and c) Initiate legal action as per rules/laws applicable iv) debarring/ blacklisting the Bidder.

- iii) ERNET India may procure, upon such terms and in such manner, as it deems appropriate, goods similar to the undelivered items/products and the defaulting Bidder shall be liable to compensate ERNET India for any extra expenditure involved towards goods and services to complete the scope of work in totality.
- iv) ERNET India may at any time terminate the purchase order by giving 15 days written notice to the Bidder, without any compensation to the Bidder, if the Bidder becomes bankrupt or otherwise insolvent.

28. ARBITRATION

- i) Any dispute or difference whatsoever arising between the parties out of or relating to the construction, meaning, scope, operation or effect of this contract or the validity or the breach thereof which cannot be amicably resolved between the parties; within 90 days from the date of raising of dispute by any of the party; shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the Rules of Domestic Commercial Arbitration of the Indian Council of Arbitration and the award made in pursuance thereof shall be binding on the parties.
- ii) The venue of Arbitration shall be Delhi.
- iii) The law governing arbitration shall be Arbitration and conciliation Act, 1996.
- iv) The language of the arbitration shall be English.
- v) Pending reference to arbitration, the parties shall make all endeavours to complete the work in all respect. Disputes, if any, will finally be settled in the arbitration.

29.APPLICABLE LAW

- i) The Bidder shall be governed by the laws and procedures established by Govt. of India, within the framework of applicable legislation and enactment made from time to time concerning such commercial dealings/processing.
- ii) All disputes in this connection shall be settled in Delhi jurisdiction only.

30.CARE OF WORK

From the commencement to the completion of the works on individual POs, the Bidder should ensure to take full responsibility for the care thereof and of all essential and incidental works and in case any damages loss or injury happens to the works or to any part thereof or to any works due to lack of precaution or negligence on the part of Bidder, the loss shall be made good at its own cost.

Annexure-4

1. Representation and Warranties Clause

The vendor represents that they are registered under Goods and Service Tax (GST) and compliant of GST provisions. Section 1- Commitments of ERNET

- 1. ERNET commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:-
- a. No employee of ERNET, personally or through family members, will in connection with the procurement process for, or the execution of a contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.
- b. ERNET will during the procurement process treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason. ERNET will in particular, before and during the procurement process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder (s) confidential/additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the process or the contract execution.
- c. ERNET will exclude from the process all known prejudiced persons.
- 2. If ERNET obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the IPC/PC Act, or it there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, ERNET will inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition can initiate disciplinary actions.

Section 4: Compensation for Damages

a. If ERNET has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the procurement process prior to the award according to Section 3, ERNET is entitled to demand and recover the damages equivalent to Earnest Money Deposit/Bid Security b. If ERNET has terminated the contract according to Section 3, or if ERNET is entitled to terminate the contract according to Section 3, ERNET shall be entitled to demand and recover from the Contractor liquidated damages of the Contract value and/or the amount equivalent to Performance Bank Guarantee.

Section 5: Previous Transgression

- a. The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last three years with any other company in any country conforming to the anti-corruption approach or with any other public sector enterprise in India that could justify his exclusion from the procurement process.
- b. If the bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the procurement process for action can be taken as per the procedure mentioned in "Guidelines on Banning of business dealings".

Section 6: Equal treatment of all Bidders/Contractors/Subcontractors

- a. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from all subcontractors a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact, and to submit it to ERNET before contract signing.
- b. ERNET will enter into agreements with identical conditions as this one with all bidders, contractors and subcontractors.
- c. ERNET will disqualify from the procurement process all bidders who do not sign this Pact or violate its provisions.

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Section 7: Criminal charges against violation Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s)/Sub contractor(s)

If ERNET obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor which constitutes corruption, or if ERNET has substantive suspicion in this regard, ERNET will inform the same to the Chief Vigilance Officer.

Section 8: Independent External Monitor/Monitors

- 1. ERNET appoints competent and credible Independent External Monitor for this Pact. The task of the Monitor is to review independently and objectively, whether and to what extent the parties comply with the obligations under this agreement.
- 2. The Monitor is not subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and performs his functions neutrally and independently. He reports to the Director General, ERNET.
- 3. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) accept that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction to all project documentation of ERNET including that provided by the Contractor. The Contractor will also grant the Monitor, upon his request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to his project documentation. The same is applicable to Subcontractors. The Monitor is under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s)/Subcontractor(s) with confidentiality.
- 4. ERNET will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meetings among the parties related to the Project provided such meetings could have an impact on the contractual relations between ERNET and the Contractor. The parties offer to the Monitor the option to participate in such meetings.
- 5. As soon as the Monitor notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement, he will so inform the Management of ERNET and request the Management to discontinue or take corrective action, or to take other relevant action. The monitor can in this regard submit non-binding recommendations. Beyond this, the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate action.
- 6. The Monitor will submit a written report to the Director General, ERNET within 8 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by ERNET and, should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.
- 7. Monitor shall be entitle to compensation on the same terms as being extended to / provided to Director level in the ERNET India or as decided by Director General of ERNET India.
- 8. If the Monitor has reported to the Director General ERNET, a substantiated suspicion of an offence under relevant IPC/PC Act, and the Director General ERNET has not, within the reasonable time taken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported it to the Chief Vigilance Officer, the Monitor may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Commissioner.
- 9. The word 'Monitor' would include both singular and plural

Section 9 - Pact Duration

1. This pact begins when both parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor 10 months after the last payment under the contract and for all other Bidders 12 months from the contract has been awarded.

2. If any claim is made / lodged during this time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this pact as specified above, unless it is discharged / determined by Director General of ERNET.

Section 10 - Other provisions

- 1. This agreement is subject to Indian Law, Place of performance and jurisdiction is the Registered Office of ERNET, i.e. New Delhi.
- 2. Changes and supplements as well as termination notices need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.
- 3. If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this agreement must be signed by all partners or consortium members.
- 4. Should one or several provisions of this agreement turn out to be invalid, the remainder of this agreement remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.
